Students for Life of America/Students for Life Action urges you to pass the following pro-life priorities. The nearly 100 student pro-life groups at schools and universities around Texas implore you to protect the most vulnerable among us--the preborn children and the women being targeted by the predatory abortion industry.

Justice demands your action. And Texas is poised to make history by taking these actions. Texas, with a pro-life governor and pro-life majorities in the House and Senate, as well as judges and justices in our judicial system committed to seeing justice done in our land, is legally situated to succeed in passing and implementing these critical pro-life measures. And in doing so they will have the support of the Pro-Life Generation in the process. We want to take a moment to tell you why.

While Millennials and Gen Z are characterized by media and pop culture as being the most radical, pro-abortion generation, nothing could be further from the truth. You see, we're the generations whose members were all born into an abortion status quo, after *Roe v. Wade* was handed down in 1973. We've seen the empty promises abortion made to our moms, sisters, friends, loved ones, and ourselves. Not only is one-third to one-fourth of our generations missing due to legal abortion, the shockwaves of these deaths have impacted nearly everyone we know in some way.


Polling confirms that the Future Is Anti-Abortion. This January, Students for Life commissioned a poll of Millennial and Gen Z voters which found that more than 7 out of 10 support limits on abortion. Millennials and Gen Z, by a margin of 57% to 30%, oppose *Roe* when they learn it allows for abortion through all 9 months. The pro-life generation encourages you to be our voice and be a pro-life legislator. Passing these bills now is the RIGHT thing to do, and the SMART thing to do. The Pro-Life Generation (thousands of students across Texas and the United States) stands in support of:

1. **SB1647/HB 3760 The Texas Abolition Strategy** · The Texas Abolition Strategy (TAS) clarifies that abolishing abortion is the goal, and TAS is the lasting strategy of how to permanently stop abortion. · The Texas Abolition Strategy is a three-in-one Pro-Life omnibus bill, combining three major Pro-Life policies into one comprehensive plan to end elective abortion in Texas: a. Preborn NonDiscrimination Act (PreNDA): Abolish discriminatory abortions motivated by the gender, ethnicity, or disability of the child and the remaining late-term abortions. b. Heartbeat: Abolish elective abortions after twelve weeks when the preborn child's heartbeat is detectable by the most common methods. c. Abolition: abolish every remaining elective abortion in Texas.
2. **SB 9/HB1280 Human Life Protection Act**-- If the Supreme Court changes its precedent and allows states to protect non-viable unborn babies, Texas needs to be ready with a new law to ban abortion to the extent allowable under the new

precedent. The Human Life Protection Act is that new law. Under the Human Life Protection Act, any person who performs an abortion (except to save the mother's life) commits a first-degree felony. Any woman on whom an abortion is performed or attempted may not be prosecuted. The law would go into effect and begin protecting unborn babies 30 days after the Supreme Court issues a judgment overruling, wholly or partly, *Roe* or *Casey*. Ten states have passed essentially the same law: Arkansas, Idaho, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, Tennessee, and Utah.

3. **SB 650/HB 1173 Defund Abortion Services Funding**--Fix last session's SB 22 to fully implement the intent of the Legislature so that the City of Austin and other political subdivisions may not pay for "abortion services" (transportation, housing, child care, etc.) to help women obtain abortions at taxpayer expense.
4. **SB 394/HB 2337 and HB 1229 Enhance our state's chemical abortion safety regulations** so that drug-induced abortions maintain adequate safety protections if the federal courts block the FDA's regulations. This helps to protect young girls from predators who have easy access to these pills and increases critical safeguards to keep women protected from dangerous chemical abortion pills.
5. **SB 802/HB 2313 by Paxton – Every Mother Matters Act (EMMA)** – Requires pre-abortion counseling and resources given outside the abortion clinic so that women have choices other than abortion.
