

Students for Life Action Key Vote Alert:

Vote NO on the *Equal Rights Amendment* H.J. Res. 25 and S.J. Res. 4 which seeks to make abortion a constitutional right all through 9 months for any reason and attacks women's rights

Members of the United States House of Representatives and United States Senators,

On behalf of our 1,300 active groups and 500,000 trained student activists across the nation, Students for Life Action urges you to vote NO on the ERA measures. These efforts would radically expand abortion access nationwide through all nine months of pregnancy, without essential protections.

Students for Life Action will score these votes, holding accountable this attack on both preborn children and states' rights. S.J. Res. 4 & H.J. Res 25 are attempts to insert the abortion in the constitution forcing Americans to go from "choice to coercion."

Our team at Students for Life Action has four additional reasons why passing H.J. Res 25/S.J. Res. 4 threatens the interests of all Americans.

- ERA will actually HURT women by wiping out all kinds of laws set up to specifically help them.
- 2. Those laws will be wiped out because ERA says there can be no favoritism in the law *by sex*, which may have made sense 100 years ago, but today there is a framework of laws protecting women and their unique interests.
- 3. Hundreds of laws in place to assist women could be negatively impacted, and it won't help law enforcement focus on crimes against women.
- 4. This would enshrine abortion into the Constitution making it virtually impossible for the states to protect life in law.

The Equal Rights Amendment has nothing to do with equal rights nor women's rights and everything about abortion, that's why we call it the "Everything Related to Abortion" act.

We are the Pro-Life Generation, so we **ask that you vote NO on the ERA, that would put abortion into the Constitution and federal law making it almost impossible for states to protect life.** We reserve the right to record your vote on our scorecard that will be shared with our activists in all 50 states and the pro-life community.
