

Students for Life Action Alert: Oppose H. RES. 1102 Which Provides Funding for Late Term Abortion Facilities

Dear Members of the U.S. House of Representatives,

On behalf of our more than 1,400 active groups and 200,000 trained student activists across the nation, *Students for Life Action* urges you **to oppose the HHS spending package which includes over \$2 million in funding for late-term abortion facilities in Rhode Island and New Hampshire.**

These late term abortion facilities not only perform late term abortions, but they openly advertise and celebrate it. It is abhorrent that the American people would be required to pay with their hard-earned tax dollars the dismembering of children in the womb. Not to mention that this also violates the Hyde Amendment, which is in federal law to protect Americans from having to pay for any abortions outside of exceptions for rape, incest, or when a mother's life is in danger.

Congressman Aderholt noted in his recent <u>news release</u>, "This is not the bill that my subcommittee produced and supported. The Senate has taken liberties with their Congressionally Directed Spending requests that would never stand in the House. The House did not include these partisan funding projects in its Labor-HHS legislation. Based on these principles, the Senate shouldn't either."

Here are the details of the earmarks the Senate added:

- Sen. Reed (D-RI), Sen. Whitehouse (D-RI), \$1,808,000 Women and Infants Hospital, RI (HRSA) Provides late-term abortions.
- Sen. Shaheen (D-NH), \$650,000 Dartmouth Hitchcock Nashua, NH (HRSA) Routinely provides late-term abortions.

Students for Life Action calls on members to uphold the law and stop funding the dismembering of children in the womb.
