

Students for Life Action Alert on FY25 pro-life appropriation protections: May 28, 2024

Dear Members of the U.S. House and Senate,

On behalf of our more than 1,400 active groups and 200,000 trained student activists across the nation, *Students for Life Action* urges you **to support strong pro-life language in the Mil Con-VA, NDAA, DOD, and AG spending for FY25. See more details below:**

1. Mil Con-VA

In <u>Section 255</u> of the current House Mil Con-VA, there is a strong pro-life provision where Republicans need to stand firm and fight for it in the final bill language.

2. NDAA & DOD

The language for the NDAA is not out yet, however, *Students for Life Action* urges members to keep any pro-life protections that are included in the bill and as always, **uphold Hyde Amendment protections**. We will let members know once the language comes out, and what sections of the bill members need to be aware of regarding their vote. As we know from last year and the Tuberville battle, the Biden administration and pro-abortion extremists in the U.S. House and U.S. Senate will stop at nothing to abuse their power and ignore federal law to fund abortion in any way they can get away with. Military families deserve better than abortion.

3. **AG**

Restore Safeguards on Mifepristone and continue to keep the pro-life provision to end mail-order chemical abortions in the Agriculture Appropriations Bill.

The Biden administration is desperately attempting to make dangerous chemical abortion drugs as available as possible without any health and safety standards in place that protect women's lives, fertility, and safety. The Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act must include language that enforces the safeguards that the FDA originally mandated on the use of mifepristone. Congress needs to protect women and their children from these dangerous drugs and from abusers forcing these deadly pills.

Students for Life Action calls on members to uphold the law and stop funding the dismembering of children in the womb in our federal budgets. See the letter we sent to the Hill on our FY25 appropriations priorities <u>HERE</u>.
